

MINI LESSON 17: PAST SIMPLE OF "TO BE"

Objective:

Learn how to use the **past forms of the verb "to be" (was/were)** in affirmative, negative, and question forms.

Grammar Point

The verb **"to be"** in the **past simple** has two forms:

Subject	Verb	

I, He, She, It was

You, We, They were

Affirmative Sentences

Subject	Past Form of "To Be"	Example
1	was	I was at home yesterday.
You	were	You were in NYC last week.
He/She/lt	was	She was tired after work.
We/They	were	They were in the park.

♦ Negative Sentences

was not = wasn't were not = weren't

Examples:

- I wasn't at school on Monday.
- They weren't ready for the test.
- He wasn't happy.



• You weren't late.

Questions

Was/Were + subject + rest of sentence?

Question Example Answer

Was she at work? Yes, she was. / No, she wasn't.

Were you late? Yes, I was. / No, I wasn't.
