

# **MINI-LESSON 2: GREETINGS & INTRODUCTIONS**

## **Objective**

Learn how to say hello, introduce yourself, and ask someone's name in English.

## **Common Greetings**

Greeting	When to Use It
Hello	Anytime, formal or informal
Hi	Informal, friendly
Good morning	Before 12:00 p.m.
Good afternoon	12:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.
Good evening	After 5:00 p.m.
What's up?	Very informal
Hey	Informal, casual

## **Introducing Yourself**

### You can say:

- I'm [Your Name]. → I'm Anna.
- My name is [Your Name]. → My name is Lucas.
   Nice to meet you!

#### Questions to ask:

- What's your name?
- How do you spell your name?



• Where are you from?

### Mini Dialogue

A: Hello!

B: Hi!

A: What's your name?

**B:** My name is Sarah. And you?

A: I'm Marco. Nice to meet you!

**B:** Nice to meet you, too!
