

MINI LESSON 22: PAST CONTINUOUS (WITH "WHILE" AND "WHEN")



Learn how to use the past continuous tense, especially in sentences with "while" and "when."

GRAMMAR EXPLANATION

The past continuous describes an action that was in progress at a specific moment in the past.

♦ Structure:

Subject + was/were + verb-ing

Subject	Be Verb	Example Verb
I / He / She / It	was	watching
You / We / They	were	studying

♦ "While" vs. "When"

- While = two long actions happening at the same time.
 Example: I was cooking while he was watching TV.
- When = a short action interrupts a longer action.

 Example: I was sleeping when the phone rang.
