



MINI-LESSON 27: TOO / ENOUGH

◆ What Does "Too" Mean?

"Too" is used to describe something that is **excessive** or **more than necessary**. It has a **negative** meaning and often expresses a problem or difficulty because of the excess.

Examples:

- The coffee is **too hot** to drink. (It's excessively hot.)
- This box is **too heavy** for me to lift. (It's too heavy for me.)

Structure:

Subject + be + too + adjective

Subject + verb + too + adjective + to + verb

- The dress is **too small**.
- She is **too tired** to go out.

◆ What Does "Enough" Mean?

"Enough" is used to describe something that is **sufficient** or **adequate**. It shows that there is **just the right amount**.

Examples:

- He has **enough money** to buy the car. (He has sufficient money.)
- This room is **big enough** for all of us. (The room is adequately large.)

Structure:

Subject + be + enough + adjective

Subject + verb + enough + noun

- She is **smart enough** to solve the problem.



- He has **enough time** to finish the homework.
