

### MINI-LESSON 29: AS...AS / NOT AS...AS



The structure **as + adjective/adverb + as** is used to show **equality** between two things or people. It means "the same as" or "equal to."

### **Examples:**

- She is as tall as her brother.
- This test is as difficult as the last one.
- He runs as fast as me.

The structure is used to compare two similar qualities or actions.

## ♦ What Does "Not As...As" Mean?

When we use **not as...as**, we are showing that **one thing is less than** the other in terms of the quality or action being compared.

#### **Examples:**

- This book is **not as interesting as** the one I read last week.
- She is not as tall as her sister.
- The exam was not as difficult as I expected.
