Learn how to use "going to" to talk about future plans or intentions.

### **Grammar Explanation:**

We use **"going to"** to express:

- Plans or intentions for the future.
  - ➤ I'm going to visit my grandparents next weekend.
- Predictions based on present evidence.
  - ➤ Look at those clouds! It's going to rain.

#### Structure:

Subject	Be verb	going to	Base verb
1	am	going to	travel
You	are	going to	eat
He/She	is	going to	study
We	are	going to	watch
They	are	going to	play

### Affirmative:

She is going to start a new job.

# X Negative:

He isn't going to come to the party.
