★ When to Use "There Is" or "There Are"

Use Structure Example

**Singular** There is There is a book on the table.

**Plural** There are three pens in the bag.

## Affirmative Sentences

- There **is** a cat on the chair.
- There **are** two windows in the room.

## Questions

To form questions, invert there is/are:

- **Is there** a bathroom?
- Are there any students in class?

## X Negative Sentences

Use **not** after "is" or "are":

- There is not (isn't) a computer.
- There are not (aren't) any books.
