

#### **MINI LESSON 9: SIMPLE PRESENT (AFFIRMATIVE)**



Learn how to form and use **affirmative sentences** in the **Simple Present Tense** to talk about routines, habits, and general truths.

# **Explanation**

The **Simple Present Tense** is used for:

- Daily routines: I wake up at 7 a.m.
- Facts and general truths: Water boils at 100°C.
- Scheduled events: The bus leaves at 9 a.m.

#### Structure:

Subject + base verb (+ s/es for he, she, it)

Subject Verb Example: "work"

I / You / We / They work

He / She / It works

# Spelling Rules for 3rd Person (He/She/It):

- Most verbs: add -s → play → plays
- Verbs ending in -ch, -sh, -ss, -x, -o: add -es → go → goes
- Verbs ending in consonant + y: change y to −ies → study → studies
- Vowel + y: just **add -s →** play **→** plays



#### Examples

- leat breakfast at 8:00.
- She **goes** to school every day.
- They watch TV in the evening.
- He **studies** English on Mondays.
- We **live** in São Paulo.
