

Mini-lesson 41: Short Answers and Tag Questions



Help students practice **short answers** to yes/no questions and form **question tags** correctly based on the verb tense and subject.

Short Answers

Use auxiliary verbs (do/does/did, be, will, etc.) for simple yes/no replies.

Examples:

- Do you like coffee? → Yes, I do. / No, I don't.
- Is she tired? → Yes, she is. / No, she isn't.
- Did they go out? → Yes, they did. / No, they didn't.

Question Tags

A question tag turns a statement into a question. If the sentence is **positive**, the tag is **negative**, and vice versa.

Examples:

- You're coming, aren't you?
- She doesn't like it, does she?
- They were at school, weren't they?
- You can swim, can't you?
- She'll go to the party, won't she?

Use the same auxiliary or modal verb as in the statement.

O Notes:

- Use do/does/did for simple tenses.
- Use **be** (am/are/is/was/were) for continuous tenses or linking verbs.
- Use will/won't, can/can't, should/shouldn't, etc., for modals.
