

Mini-lesson 43: Simple Real Conditionals (Zero & First)

■ What Are Simple Real Conditionals?

Simple real conditionals describe things that are **always true** (general facts) or **possible in the future** (real situations). These include the **Zero Conditional** and the **First Conditional**.

♦ Zero Conditional – General Facts & Habits

Form:

If + present simple, present simple

Use it for:

- General truths
- Scientific facts
- Routines and habits

Examples:

- If you heat ice, it melts.
- If I drink coffee at night, I can't sleep.
- If people don't exercise, they gain weight.

The order can be reversed:

I can't sleep if I drink coffee at night.

♦ First Conditional – Real Possibilities in the Future

Form:

If + present simple, will + base verb

Use it for:

- Likely future events
- Warnings
- Promises or plans

Examples:

- If it rains, I will stay home.
- If you **study**, you **will pass** the test.
- If they don't hurry, they won't catch the bus.
- ✓ The order can be reversed:

I will stay home if it rains.
