

Mini-lesson 50: Internet & Text Abbreviations

Objective:

To help learners understand and use common internet and text message abbreviations (acronyms and initialisms) in informal English communication.

Explanation:

Internet and texting abbreviations are **shortened forms of words or phrases** commonly used in chats, social media, and text messages. They help **save time and space** when typing.

They are often written in **all capital letters**, but not always. Some represent **phrases**, while others are **short forms of words**.

Common Abbreviations

Abbreviation	Meaning	Example Sentence
LOL	Laughing Out Loud	That meme was so funny, LOL!
BRB	Be Right Back	Gotta grab a snack. BRB!
OMG	Oh My God	OMG, I can't believe you did that!
IDK	I Don't Know	IDK what time the movie starts.
BTW	By The Way	BTW, did you finish the homework?
ТМІ	Too Much Information	Ew! TMI, I didn't need to know that!
IMO / IMHO	In My Opinion / In My Humble Opinion	IMO, that show is overrated.
ROFL	Rolling On the Floor Laughing	That joke had me ROFL.
BFF	Best Friends Forever	She's my BFF from high school.
THX / TY	Thanks / Thank You	THX for the help earlier!
NP	No Problem	TY! – NP! 😊
DM	Direct Message	Just DM me the details.



Abbreviation	Meaning	Example Sentence
TTYL	Talk To You Later	I'm heading out now. TTYL!
LMAO	Laughing My A** Off	That video had me LMAO.
FOMO	Fear Of Missing Out	I didn't go, but now I have FOMO.
AFK	Away From Keyboard	AFK for 10 mins.
ASAP	As Soon As Possible	Send me that file ASAP.
SMH	Shaking My Head	SMH some people just don't get it.
NVM	Never Mind	NVM, I figured it out.
TL;DR	Too Long; Didn't Read	TL;DR: She said no.

Notes:

- These abbreviations are typically used in **informal** writing (texts, DMs, comments).
- Avoid using them in formal writing (emails to your boss, academic writing, etc.).
- Some have **mild profanity** (e.g., LMAO), so use with caution depending on the audience.
